Application for Membership in PCNS

The Pacific Coast Numismatic Society invites all interested persons to join PCNS, the first numismatic organization established in the Western United States. PCNS was founded by Farran Zerbe when he came to San Francisco to supervise the U.S. Mint Exhibit at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition in 1915.

PCNS was originally organized as a meeting ground for San Francisco Bay Area collectors and students, but it also was envisioned as a clearinghouse for numismatists throughout the American West. PCNS has continued to serve as a local meeting place for the more studious numismatists of the San Francisco Bay Area, but its wider goals are not forgotten.

PCNS issues publications which are provided to all members as a benefit of membership. Annual awards are made for numismatic writings, and those papers appear in our publications.

Monthly meetings are held in San Francisco, and a monthly PDF bulletin is emailed to all members with details of each meeting event. Meetings feature a numismatic presentation, and all members are encouraged to take part in discussions and the display of material related to the meeting topic. Guests are always welcome at PCNS meetings.

Membership requirements, as stated in the PCNS Constitution, are: any person of good character who is interested in the objects and activities of the Society and who agrees to abide by its rules shall be eligible for membership.

Dues are \$20 per calendar year, which must be submitted with the application. Members receive all annual publications, monthly bulletins and meeting announcements, and enjoy all other rights as described in the Constitution & Bylaws or approved by the Board of Governors.
